

WHO IS A CHRISTIAN, WHAT DOES HE DO, AND WHY?

In this sheet Kenneth King asks his pastor, Mitch Green, some common questions that people have.

Q: Who is a Christian?

A: According to the Bible a Christian is a person that has invited Jesus into their lives, asked for forgiveness of their sins and is following His example and teachings.

Q: Why do Christians read the bible?

A: It is the truth on which we need to live. It is the only source to know who God is, Who Jesus is and how to live a life that pleases and serves Him.

Q: What is the point of church and why do Christians go?

A: Church is about worshipping & serving God and growing more like Jesus. Contrary to most of our world - we do not go to church because of what we GET from it - but what we can GIVE God, worship and service to Him. It's not about being entertained - We are not the audience for God to play to, we are the ones that strive to please Him. Also - He has commanded us to meet together and keep the Lord's Day holy.

Q: Why do Christians always talk about their faith?

A: Because Jesus commanded us to. If we do not talk about Jesus, people will not know the truth and miss out on a relationship with God through faith in Jesus and spend eternity separated from God.

Q: What is the difference between Christianity and all the other religions?

A: This one is not an easy one to answer, as each religion has its own beliefs. The most significant one is who each religion believes Jesus to be. Christianity believes that Jesus is God in the flesh, who lived a sinless life, died on a cross to pay for our sins, rose again conquering death and the penalty of our sin and that only through faith in Him, are we saved. (John 14:6). Other religions believe Jesus to be a spirit-filled man, a prophet, a good-teacher, etc. We believe that Jesus is **THE ONLY WAY** and that we are saved by **GRACE**, not works.
